



Peace Lutheran Church Indoor In-person worship Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) Will we wear masks?** Yes. This is an act of hospitality to those who cannot be vaccinated and it adds to the overall comfort levels for all people, including visitors. Please note: worship leaders have all been fully vaccinated. They will remove their masks when leading singing, preaching and reading.
- 2) How will the sanctuary be set up?** The rows will have six feet of legroom between them. The chairs will be in complete rows. We ask households to keep two chairs between them. This will ensure people in a variety of household sizes can easily find a place to sit and everyone will be kept distanced.
- 3) What about singing?** You are welcome to sing softly.
- 4) How will communion be distributed?** Communion will be distributed using individual cups and wafers. People will pick up cups on their own and Pastor Sarah will give wafers using tongs.
- 5) What about overflow?** As we aren't taking registrations, we don't know exactly how many people to expect. If we get more people than can safely fit in the sanctuary, we will seat overflow in the Fellowship Hall with a screen.
- 6) Will there be extra fans?** Our HVAC system has a good fan that will run. There will be a few extra floor fans too.
- 7) What time should I arrive?** It will be helpful if everyone can be seated by 10:20 for the 10:30 service.
- 8) What's happening at 8:00?** The 8:00 service will meet in the Fellowship Hall with communion. It will be on zoom to include worshipers at home too.
- 9) And the most important question - Is there coffee?** No coffee will be served at church at this time. All chatter and fellowship will take place outdoors.
